FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SW WESTERN AVE (BH – ALLEN BLVD) IMPROVEMENTS; COB\_1.1 16-Inch Water Main Improvements; and MPE\_1.1 WWSP 48-Inch Water Transmission Pipeline  
Solicitation #3716-21B**

**DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT.** The City of Beaverton is accepting sealed bids for the project, Western Ave (BH Hwy – Allen Blvd) Improvements Project (CIP No. 3328), COB 16-Inch Watermain Improvements, & WWSP MPE 1.1 48-Inch Water Transmission Line. The project consists of 3,600 feet of roadway improvements (pavement, concrete cycle track, concrete walks, planter strip, street lighting, and storm drainage), 3,800 LF of 16-inch ductile iron waterline and associated structures (CIP No. 4172), and 3,500 LF of 48-inch welded steel waterline and associated structures (WWSP Project 151427). The estimated project cost is approximately between \$ 20 million and \$ 22 million.

1. **DEADLINE.** Bids must be submitted by 2 p.m. on March 25, 2021. First-tier Subcontractor Disclosure Forms for this project are due no later than 4 p.m. on March 25, 2021 to Terry Muralt, Purchasing Agent, by fax, (503) 526-2490, or by email, [bidmail@BeavertonOregon.gov](mailto:bidmail@BeavertonOregon.gov).

2. **DELIVERY METHODS.**

The City will only accept bid packets for this project electronically. Hard copies or facsimiles (fax) will not be accepted. Questions that cannot be addressed by direct reference to the Bid Documents may be answered through an addendum issued to all plan holders. **A bidder's failure to attend the mandatory pre-bid conference shall cause the bidder's bid to be deemed non-responsive.**

5. **LOCATION OF SPECIFICATIONS.** Bidders may obtain plans and specifications for the project by visiting the City's website at <http://apps2.BeavertonOregon.gov/Bids/> after registering an account with the City and subscribing to the bid.

6. **ODOT APPROVAL LETTER.** Bidders must submit or have on file with the City's Purchasing Division a current letter of approval from the State of Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Construction Contracts Unit showing that

Contractor has been preapproved for the following class or classes of work: Earthwork and Drainage. City must receive the letter no later than 2 hours after bid closing time stated in Section 2.

7. **FEDERAL FUNDING.** This project is partially funded with federal funds through the Water Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act (WIFIA). Attention is drawn to federal laws which will apply to this contract including the American Iron and Steel Requirement, Equal Opportunity, Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Good Faith Efforts and other requirements. These requirements may be found in Exhibit 2 and 3 of the Contract.
8. **PREVAILING WAGES.** The contract expected to be awarded in connection with this solicitation is subject to the state prevailing wage rates under ORS 279C.800 to 279C.870 and/or the federal prevailing wage rates under the Davis-Bacon Act (40 U.S.C. 3141 *et seq.*). No Bid will be received or considered by the City unless the Bid contains a statement by the Bidder that "Bidder agrees to be bound by and will comply with the provisions of ORS 279C.838, ORS 279C.840 or 40 U.S.C. 3141 to 3148."
