INVITATION TO BID FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF DOVER SOUTH UTILITY REHABILITATION, CIP 8098A Solicitation #3864-22B

1. **DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT.** The City of Beaverton is accepting will only accept electronic bids for the project, Dover South Utility Rehabilitation, CIP 8098A. The project consists of storm drainage improvements (installation of 1,800 lineal feet of 10"-48" pipe, 12" CIPP lining, manholes, catch basins), sanitary sewer improvements (manholes and 3,500 lineal feet of 6"-8" CIPP lining). The project cost is approximately between \$1,250,000 and \$1,450,000.
2. **DEADLINE.** Bids must be submitted by 2 p.m. on November 23, 2021. First-tier Subcontractor Disclosure Forms for this project are due no later than 4 p.m. on November 23, 2021 to Terry Muralt, Purchasing Agent, by fax, (503) 526-2490, or by email, bidmail@BeavertonOregon.gov.
3. **DELIVERY METHODS.**
 - a. The City will only accept bid packets for this project electronically. Hard copies or facsimiles (fax) will not be accepted. Please scan your bid packet in and submit your bid packet as a pdf document to Equity Hub's Bid Locker at:

6. **LOCATION OF SPECIFICATIONS.** Bidders may obtain plans and specifications for the project by visiting the City's website at <http://apps2.BeavertonOregon.gov/Bids/> after registering an account with the City and subscribing to the bid.
7. **ODOT APPROVAL LETTER.** Bidders must submit or have on file with the City's Purchasing Division a current letter of approval from the State of Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Construction Contracts Unit showing that Contractor has been preapproved for the following class or classes of work: (EART)-Earthwork and Drainage. City must receive the letter no later than the date and time established in Section 4.
8. **PREVAILING WAGES.** The contract expected to be awarded in connection with this solicitation is subject to the state prevailing wage rates under ORS 279C.800 to 279C.875 and/or the federal prevailing wage rates under the

Davis-Bacon Act (40 U.S.C. 3141 *et seq.*). No Bid will be received or considered by the City unless the Bid contains a statement by the Bidder that “Bidder agrees to be bound by and will comply with the provisions of ORS 279C.838, ORS 279C.840 or 40 U.S.C. 3141 to 3148.”
