All required permits and approvals must be obtained and completed under applicable local, state, and federal law. In addition, the following conditions apply to the project.

In order to comply with Clean Water Services water quality protection requirements the project must comply with the following conditions:

- 1. Final development plans outlining the approved encroachments are attached. Should final development plans differ significantly from those submitted for review by Clean Water Services, the applicant shall provide updated drawings, and if necessary, obtain a revised Service Provider Letter.
- 2. Removal of native, woody vegetation shall be limited to the greatest extent practicable.
- 3. Prior to installation of plant materials, all invasive species vegetation with the Vegetated Corridor shall be removed per methods described in Clean Water Services' Integrated Pest Management Plan, 2019. During removal of invasive vegetation, care shall be taken to minimize impacts to existing native tree and shrub species.
- 4. Protection of the Vegetated Corridors and associated sensitive areas shall be provided by the installation of permanent signage between the development and the outer limits of the Vegetated Corridors.

This Service Provider Letter is not valid unless CWS-approved site plan is attached.


