Pursuant to City of Beaverton staff comments made at a meeting with Beaverton School District (BSD) staff concerning the placement of temporary portable classrooms at Greenway Elementary School (9150 SW Downing Drive), BSD offers the following comments to the record for the above referenced casefiles.

1. BDC Section 60.05.40.2.

60.05.40. Circulation and Parking Design Guidelines. Unless otherwise noted, all guidelines apply in all zoning districts.	
2. Loading area, solid waste facilities, and similar improvements. A. On-Site service, storage and similar activities should be designed and located so that these facilities are screened from an abutting public street. (Standard 60.05.20.2) B. Except in Industrial districts, loading areas should be designed and located so that these facilities are screened from an abutting public street, or are shown to be compatible with local business operations. (Standard	Greenway ES has an existing solid waste station located immediately east of the cafeteria. The solid waste area is screened by permanent walls and slatted chain-link. The access gate is opposite a dedicated drive aisle dedicated for refuse vehicles. There is no parking in the immediate vicinity of the solid waste area. No additional service demand will be created with the proposed project. Therefore, this guideline is met.
