Bringing services into our Aging Community

- 13th and 14th August weekend: our four residents all had visitors from the local neighborhood that do not drive. Three visitors walked and two rode bikes.
- We have responded to calls and assisted neighbors with covid up off the floor after falls in their private residences.
- We accepted a local resident who experienced 31 falls in 30 days at previous community. She has had one fall in 9 months since her move to Rooted Care.
- We took a man near death into our AFH and gave him 8 more months of comfortable, safe life.
- We have connected with the church and pool to engage as good neighbors.
- 4 of our 5 current residents have family living less than a mile away.
- We ordered a little library to share with the community.
- We hosted a community Easter egg hunt with bunny and bounce house for neighbors and had good turn out.
- We rented the Kona ice truck for the neighborhood to get to know us and our residents.
- We bathed a man who hadn't had a bath in nine months.
- We provided respite care *from being full time caregiver of her husband with Parkinson's disease* so a neighbor could go on a needed vacation.
- We have 100% positive reviews.
- We meet and exceed all current regulations for AFH and for RCF.
- We work closely to help overfilled hospitals discharge patients who no longer need hospital services
- Accepting residents from full hospitals reduces ER wait times and reduces ER redirecting of non-emergency cases.
- We are fully Sprinklered, and the home meets all DHS RCF requirements.
- Owner has been in long term care for 22 plus years with good outcomes. She has a BSN and near completion of MBA. She is board certified in gerontology and assisted living.
- We use evidence-based care for quality outcomes.
- We are good neighbors. We deserve a chance.
- We need to take care of those that once took care of us.
- This is an aging neighborhood and we have already shown we are ready and committing to serving our neighbors when needed.
- We are the first senior home community in 20 years to support Death with Dignity.
