ORDER NO. 2617 ADJ2018-0004 ORDER APPROVING BEAVERTON PUBLIC SAFETY CENTER, MAJOR ADJUSTMENT

The matter came before the Planning Commission on July 11, 2018, on a request for development of a three-story Public Safety Center, approximately 72,000 square feet in size. The applicant requests approval of a Major Adjustment to exceed the maximum building height of the Community Service (CS) zone by seven (7) feet. The site is located on the south side of Allen Boulevard, between SW Main Avenue and SW Hall Boulevard. The site is also identified as Tax Lots 200, 500, 602, 701, 1200, 1400, 1700 and 1800 on Washington County Tax Assessor's Map 1S121AA.

Pursuant to Ordinance 2050 (Development Code) Section 50.45, the Planning Commission conducted a public hearing; reviewed exhibits; and considered testimony on the subject proposal.

The Commission, after holding the public hearing and considering all oral and written testimony, adopts the Staff Report dated July 3, 2018, and the

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findings contained therein, as applicable to the approval criteria contained in Section 40.10.15.2.C of the Development Code.
