The matter came before the Planning Commission on October 26, 2016, on a request for a Major Adjustment to reduce the side yard setback for all lots to 3 feet. The subject site is located at 4815 SW Murray Boulevard and 14570 SW Farmington Road. Tax Lots 2800 & 3000 on Washington County Tax Assessor's Map 1S117AD.

Pursuant to Ordinance 2050 (Development Code) Section 50.45, the Planning Commission conducted a public hearing and considered testimony and exhibits on the subject proposal.

The Commission, after holding the public hearing and considering all oral and written testimony, adopts the Staff Report dated October 19, 2016, Supplemental Memorandum dated October 25, 2016 and the findings contained therein, as applicable to the approval criteria contained in Sections 40.10.15.2.C of the Development Code.

Therefore, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that **ADJ2016-0005** is **APPROVED**, based on the testimony, reports and exhibits, and evidence presented during the public hearing on the matter and based on the facts, findings, and conclusions found in the Staff Report dated October 19, 2016, Supplemental Memorandum dated October 25, 2016 and the findings contained therein, subject to the conditions of approval as follows:

1. Ensure that the associated Preliminary Subdivision Application (LD2016-0014) has been approved and is consistent with the submitted plans. (Planning Division/JF)
