The subject site is located north of SW Barnes Road, east of NW 118th Avenue, west of NW 117th Loop and south of NW Cedar Falls Drive. The project site is also identified as Tax Lots 6300, 6400 and 6500 on Washington County Assessor's Map 1N134CD. The subject site is located within the Tuefel Nursery / Timberland Planned Unit Development (CU2004-0015 and CU2004-0016).

- 3. Submit a final shared parking agreement to be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney, or designee. (Planning / ES)
