The matter came before the Planning Commission at a hearing on July 10, 2024, which was continued to August 7, 2024, on a request for a Variance request to reduce the required minimum lighting level for on-site walkways contained in Section 60.55 (Transportation Facilities). The site is located at 7360 SW Pointer Road, specifically identified as Tax Lots 3301 and 4001 on Washington County Tax Assessor’s Map 1S101DC.

Pursuant to Ordinance 2050 (Development Code) Section 50.45, the Planning Commission conducted a public hearing and considered testimony and exhibits on the subject proposal.

The Commission, after holding the public hearing and considering all oral and written testimony, adopts the Staff Report dated July 3, 2024, the Supplemental Memoranda dated July 10, 2024, and August 1, 2024, and the findings contained therein, as applicable to the approval criteria contained in Section 40.95.15.1 of the Development Code.

Therefore, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that **VAR32024-00079** is **APPROVED**, based on the testimony, reports and exhibits, and evidence presented during the public hearing on the matter and based on the facts, findings, and conclusions found in the Staff Report dated July 3, 2024, the

Supplemental Memoranda dated July 10, 2024, and August 1, 2024, and the findings contained therein, subject to the conditions of approval as follows:

A. General Conditions, the applicant shall:

1. Ensure that the Design Review Three (DR32023-00665) application has been approved and is consistent with the submitted plans. (Planning / BG)
2. Ensure that the New Conditional Use (CUN32023-00798) application has been approved and is consistent with the submitted plans. (Planning / BG)
