The matter came before the Planning Commission on September 21, 2022, on a request for an Annexation-Related Discretionary Comprehensive Plan Map Amendment for part of a site made up of eight parcels at 1065 SW 181st Avenue and 17940 – 18110 W Baseline Road, specifically identified as Tax Lots 3600, 3700, 3702, 3800, 3900, 4000, 4100, and 4200 on Washington County Tax Assessor's Map 1S106BC, and abutting right of way on 179th Avenue. The request was to apply the City's Station Community land use designation to the portion of the site in Washington County's TO: R18-24 Land Use District and to the abutting portion of 179th Avenue.

Pursuant to Ordinance 4187 (Comprehensive Plan) Section 1.6, the Planning Commission conducted a public hearing and considered testimony and exhibits on the subject proposal.

The Commission, after holding the public hearing and considering all oral and written testimony, adopts the Staff Report dated September 14, 2022,

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and the Staff Memorandum dated September 21, 2022, and the findings contained therein, as applicable to the approval criteria contained in Section 1.5.1.B of the Comprehensive Plan.
