The matter came before the Planning Commission on October 4, 2023, on a request for a Quasi-Judicial Discretionary Zoning Map Amendment to apply the City's General Commercial (GC) zone to one parcel and abutting right of way. The property is currently designated Residential Mixed B (RMB) and is at 16290 NW Bronson Road, specifically identified as tax lot 18800 on Washington County Tax Assessor's Map 1N129CC.

Pursuant to Ordinance 2050 (Development Code) Section 50.45, the Planning Commission conducted a public hearing and considered testimony and exhibits on the subject proposal.

The Commission, after holding the public hearing and considering all oral and written testimony, adopts the Staff Report dated September 27, 2023, the supplemental memo dated October 3, 2023, and the findings contained therein, as applicable to the approval criteria contained in Section 40.97.15.1.C of the Development Code.

Therefore, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Planning Commission **RECOMMENDS APPROVAL** of **ZMA32023-00536** to the City Council, based on the testimony, reports and exhibits, and evidence presented during the public hearing on the matter and based on the facts, findings, and conclusions found in the Staff Report dated September 27, 2023, and the supplemental memo dated October 3, 2023.
