Summary of The applicant, Convergence Architecture, requests Single-Detached and Application: Middle Housing Design Review One approval to construct three quadplex

buildings. Site improvements include a parking lot, shared outdoor spaces, site landscaping, trash enclosures, and a pedestrian walkway between the proposed parking lot and SW Hall Boulevard. A Preliminary Partition is requested to divide the site into three legal lots of record, with each

proposed quadplex on a separate lot.

The Facilities Review Committee is not a decision-making body but advises the Director on a project's conformity to the technical criteria specified in Section 40.03.1 of the Beaverton Development Code. The Facilities Review Committee meeting is open to the public but is not intended for public testimony.
