Ordinance Annexing One Parcel of Land Located at 3450 SW 110th Avenue; Withdrawing the Property From the Washington County Enhanced Sheriff's Patrol District and Washington County Urban Road Maintenance District; and adding the Property to the Central Beaverton Neighborhood Association Committee; Annexation ANX2019-0003. The subject property is identified as tax lot.

A decision to approve the proposed annexation will occur through the adoption of an ordinance by the City Council. The Council's first reading of the ordinance will occur on June 4, 2019. The Council's second reading and decision regarding adoption, is scheduled for June 11, 2019. The decision on annexation will not authorize or prevent any specific use of land.

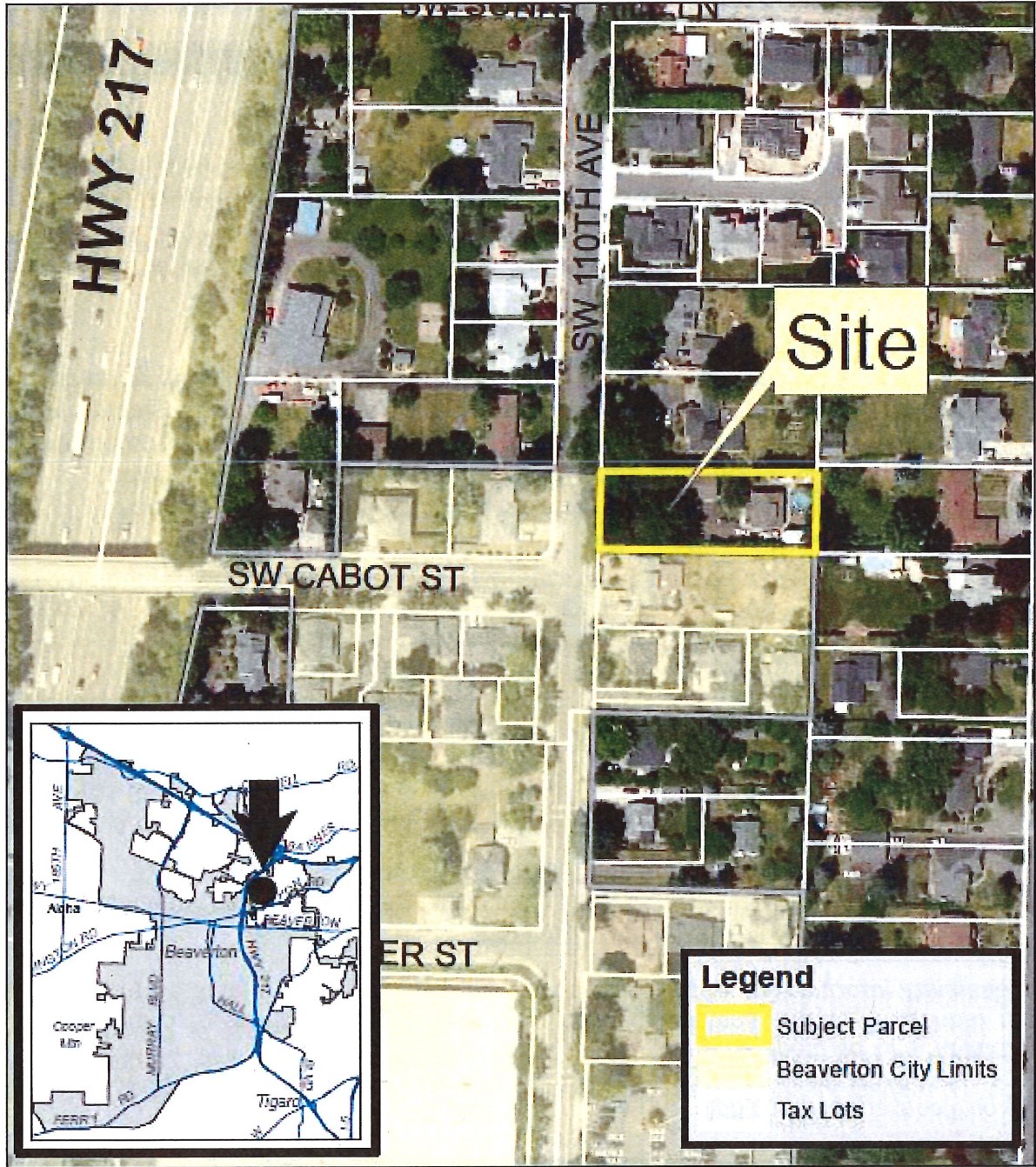
