Summary of Application: The applicant, Baysinger Partners Architecture, requests Modification of a Replat One approval (LD2021-0002 Allen Redevelopment: Hotel and Commercial Development) to modify a condition of approval related to recordation of the final plat for lot consolidation.

Project Location: The site is located at 10700 SW Allen Boulevard on the south side of SW Allen and east of Highway 217, specifically identified as Tax Lots 100, 200, 400, and 500 on Washington County Tax Assessor's Map 1S122AA.

Zoning & NAC: Community Service (CS) / Denny Whitford/Raleigh West NAC

Applicable Approval Criteria: Development Code Section 40.45.15.2.C *Replat One* and Section 50.95.7 *Modification of a Decision*
