Summary of The applicant, TNHC Oregon, LLC (AKA The New Home Company), Application: requests Design Review Two approval for the construction of 32

single-family attached (townhome) dwellings within Phase 2 of the previously approved Vineyard at Cooper Mountain Planned Unit Development (CU2018-0014). The review is generally limited to the proposed building articulation and variety, landscaping, and lighting. The original Planned Unit Development received approval under the 2017 Development Code, therefore the applicant's required Design Review Two application will be reviewed under the same code. At the time of the Planned Unit Development approval, the subject site was zoned Urban Medium Density (R2), Urban Medium Density (R4), Urban Standard Density (R5) and Urban Standard Density (R7). The proposed single-family attached dwellings are located within the portions of the site zoned R2 (Lots156-170 and 186-198) and R4 (Lots

171-174).

Assessor's Map 1S131 and is located west of SW 175th Avenue.
