Summary of Application:

Project Location:

The applicants, Washington County and the City of Beaverton, request approval of a Public Transportation Facility for improvements to the SW Denney Road right of way from SW 105th Avenue east to SW Scholls Ferry Road, including adding bike lanes, curb and gutter, planter strips, sidewalks, and an intermittent turn lane; a Sidewalk Design Modification for several portions of the sidewalk and planter strip on SW Denney Road to be narrower than the minimum required widths; and a Tree Plan Two for the removal of 16 Community Trees and two trees within a Significant Grove to accommodate the physical improvements to SW Denney Road.

The project area is largely within existing right of way along SW Denney

Road between SW 105th Avenue to SW Scholls Ferry Road. The proposal also includes minor acquisitions and/or temporary easements to

approximately 31 parcels along this portion of SW Denney Road.

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
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Beaverton VICINITY MAP
