Summary of Applications:	The applicant, Kim-Hein Nguyen, requests approval of a Preliminary Partition to create two new parcels from the existing lot, a Legal Lot Determination to determine the legal status of the subject lot, and a Variance to reduce the minimum side setback of the existing single-detached dwelling to the edge of the proposed shared driveway from five feet to 1'-8".
