Hello Elena,

I live next to the proposed Beaverton Senior Living project. I am concerned about Tree Plan Two (TP2019-0011) "for the removal of approximately 20 Community Trees."

Please tell me this does not include the 5+ beautiful large pines at the southwest end of the project site! I live in The Crossings at Tanasbourne (790 NW 185th), right next to the property line. Abundant wildlife call those trees home! Given the height and girth of these trees, they appear to me to be old growth trees. If the developers plan to remove these trees, they must be persuaded to build around them and incorporate them into the landscaping. I have seen many building sites do the same. While nearby construction would disturb the wildlife, it would not be a permanent disruption.

Thank you for the outlet to express my concerns. I do plan to be at the Hearing meeting January 8, 2020, at 6:30pm. Please let me know what I might do to help keep these trees intact!
