



standard features of a Craftsman house are the rectangular floor plan, often with a hip roof and hipped dormers. The Clements house has the added feature of bell-cast eaves, both on the main volume of the house as well as on the dormers. Other decorative elements include the polygonal bay windows and the beveled glass in the front door.

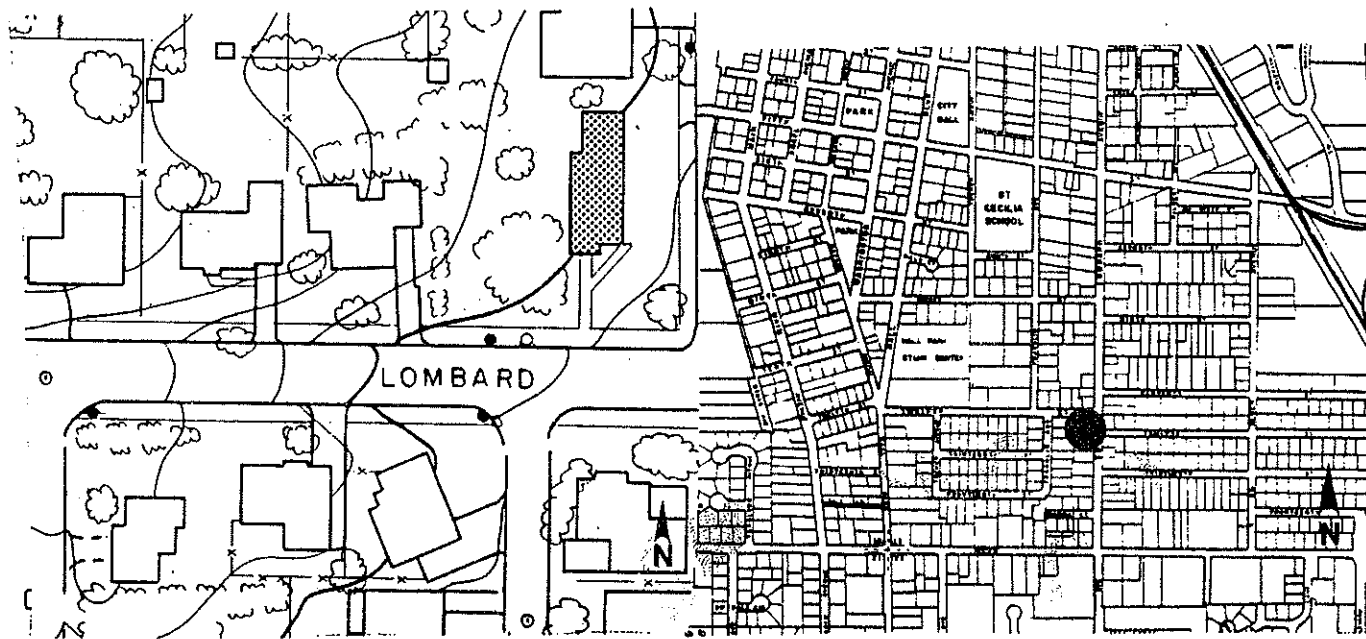

Key:

**Significant:** Individually the important buildings, sites, structures or objects in Beaverton distinguished by outstanding qualities of architecture, relationship to environment and/or historic associations.

**Important:** Buildings, sites, structures or objects, which are not of outstanding distinctiveness or variety, in terms of architecture or historic association and/or relationship to environment, but have sufficient significance to make them worthy of preservation.

**Contributing:** Buildings, sites, structures or objects, which are less significant examples of architecture or of lesser historical association. They may also provide the contexts for more significant resources.

**Unrankable:** These resources lack sufficient information to be ranked. When that information is available, those found to be Significant or Important shall be recommended by the HARC for designation as Landmarks.
