We recently purchased our home at 7000 SW Tierra Del Mar Dr, Beaverton OR 97007. Unbeknown to us at the time of purchase the neighboring property at 6996 SW Tierra Del Mar Dr, Beaverton OR 97007, Hartwood Hylands LOT 118 is proposed for logging of several "Community Trees" adjacent to our newly purchased property.

This is a formal complaint of the removal of large "old growth" fir and cottonwood trees on or next to the property line and along Johnston Creek. Removal of the trees on or near the property will greatly compromise the integrity and overall health of the forest, leaving our property, home and trees vulnerable to erosion, storm and wind damage. The removal of these trees in question will also devalue the property, increase road noise, and take away from the privacy we valued when we purchased the home and property. None of this was disclosed to us as home buyers when purchasing the property, even when we inquired about it, prior to purchase.

Please reconsider the excessive removal of trees on the said property adjacent to ours.
