

SPECIAL MEETING
May 3, 2000

CALL TO ORDER:

A special meeting of the Beaverton City Council was called to order by Mayor Rob Drake in the Third Floor Conference Room, 4755 SW Griffith Drive, Beaverton, Oregon, on Wednesday, May 3, 2000 at 6:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL:

Present were Mayor Drake, Couns. Evelyn Brzezinski, Dennis Doyle, Forrest Soth, and Cathy Stanton. Also present was City Recorder Darleen Cogburn.

CITIZEN COMMUNICATION:

There was no one present who wished to speak.

COUNCIL ITEMS:

There were none.

APPLICANT INTERVIEWS FOR INTERIM COUNCIL POSITION

The following format was used: Each Councilor asked one question, reading the question from the list of questions provided. There were six questions (in the record), and the Councilors rotated through the questions with each candidate in the following order: Couns. Brzezinski, Soth, Stanton and Doyle. Each candidate was interviewed individually, not in the presence of any other candidate.

The same format was used for all the interviews, and there was no discussion by the Council during the breaks between candidates.

Council President Evelyn Brzezinski explained the process/format to each of the applicants.

Interviews:

Marina Gardiner was the first applicant interviewed. Her interview began at 6:00 p.m. and concluded at 6:10 p.m.

Council recessed until the next applicant.

Brian Lynott was interviewed next. His interview began at 6:43 p.m. and concluded at 7:05 p.m.

Council recessed until the next applicant.

Jim Persey was the next applicant interviewed. His interview began at 7:30 p.m. and concluded at 7:45 p.m.

Council recessed until the next applicant.

Fred Ruby was the next applicant. His interview began at 8:13 p.m. and concluded at 8:31 p.m.

At the conclusion of the interviews of the applicants the Councilors agreed to vote without discussion, to see whether they were in agreement.

Coun. Soth MOVED, SECONDED by Coun. Stanton, to appoint Fred Ruby.

Coun. Doyle said he supported the motion. He said it certainly was not an easy choice because there had been many excellent answers to the questions, and it appeared that all the applicants would have been consensus builders.

Coun. Stanton said she would support the motion, and building on what Coun. Doyle had said, she noted that for her, three of Ruby's answers were perfect. She stated that Persey was certainly a strong second.

Question called on the motion. Couns. Soth, Stanton, Doyle and Brzezinski voting AYE, motion CARRIED unanimously. (4:0)

ADJOURNMENT:

There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, the special meeting was adjourned at 8:48 p.m.
